Thank you everyone who sold and bought from our fundraiser! I will admit this fundraiser was not as successful as previous sales, but hey its money for the program that we did not have before!

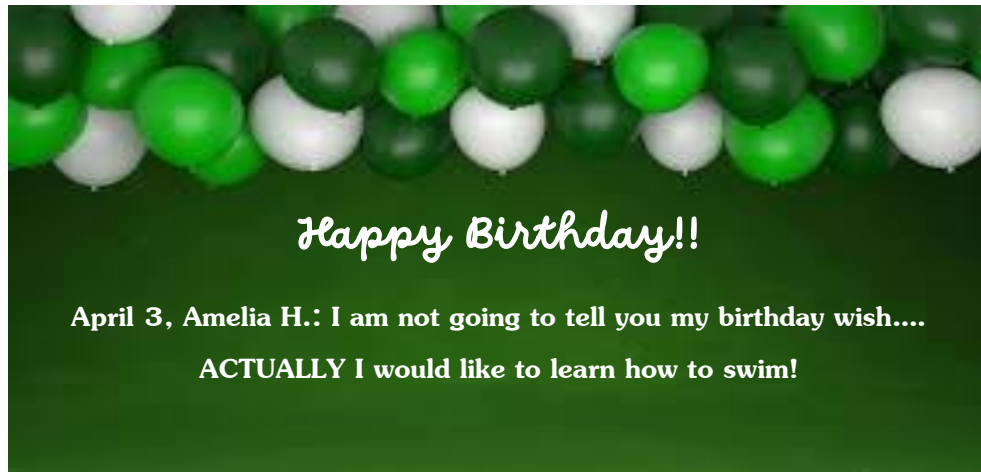
