ROCKY MOUNTAIN ROOM

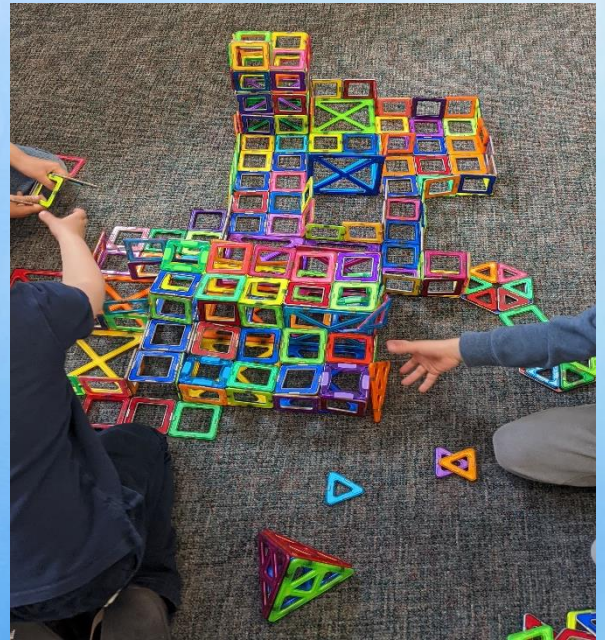
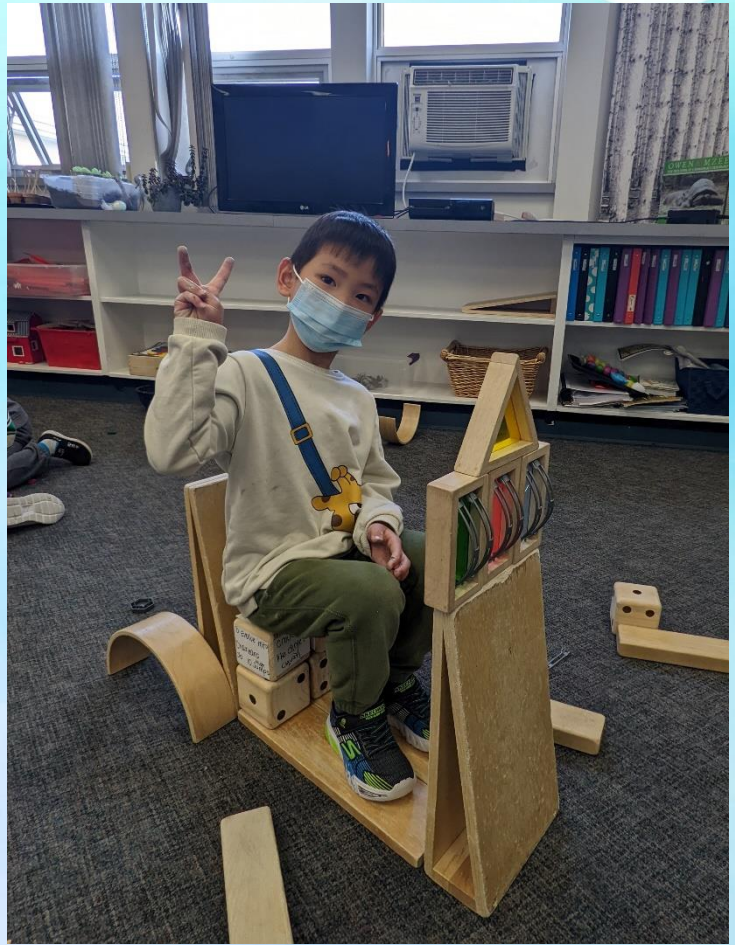
- The kids in the Rocky room have still been very interested in STEM and building cool structures.
